- 6. Documenting programs and activities aimed at quality improvement.
- Serving as the central agency within the institution for coordinating quality-related activities and disseminating best practices.
- 8. Developing and maintaining an institutional database through Management Information Systems (MIS) to enhance institutional quality.
- Conducting periodic Academic and Administrative Audits and ensuring follow-up actions to improve quality culture within the institution.
